

Text-based Intervention – Grammar (Adjectives)

Adjectives
Adjectives are describing words. They give extra information about people or things – **nouns**. Adjectives are usually positioned in front of the **noun** they describe.

Numerical Adjectives
Relates to number and the order of things.

Descriptive Adjectives
The most common type of adjective; describes things or people.

number: **seven** people, **one** hundred years, **each** day.

fantastic planet
silly people
large elephant

The **long** **slow** walk up the path was **exhausting** and **painful**, because I wore my **new** shoes.

order of things: **first**, **second**, **final**.

indefinite number: **a few** problems, **some** hope.

Comparison of Adjectives
Adjective have three degrees of comparison or quality: **positive**, **comparative** and **superlative**.

Adjectives

Positive
She ran **fast**
His car is **messy**

Comparative
She ran **faster**
His car is **messier**

Superlative
She ran the **fastest**
His car is the **messiest**
