The target words are CVC words. That is, each word has three sounds, two are **consonant** sounds (C), and one is a **vowel** sound (V). In these activities the vowels are all *short* vowels – aioeu - and are consistently the same sound when spelling.


Directions

- Cover completed words before starting the exercises.


<u>Tips</u>


- Cover the target words.
- Encourage your child to sound out the sounds while writing the letters.
- Feedback for errors, i.e. your child writes bad for dad. Say, 'The first sound in this word is /d/. Listen as I say the sound /d/.' Point to the letter b at child's attempt to write dad. Say. 'This is the b/ sound. The first sound is /d/.' Point to both the d and the b spellings. Ask your child, 'What do you need to do?' (Swap the b spelling with the d spelling
