

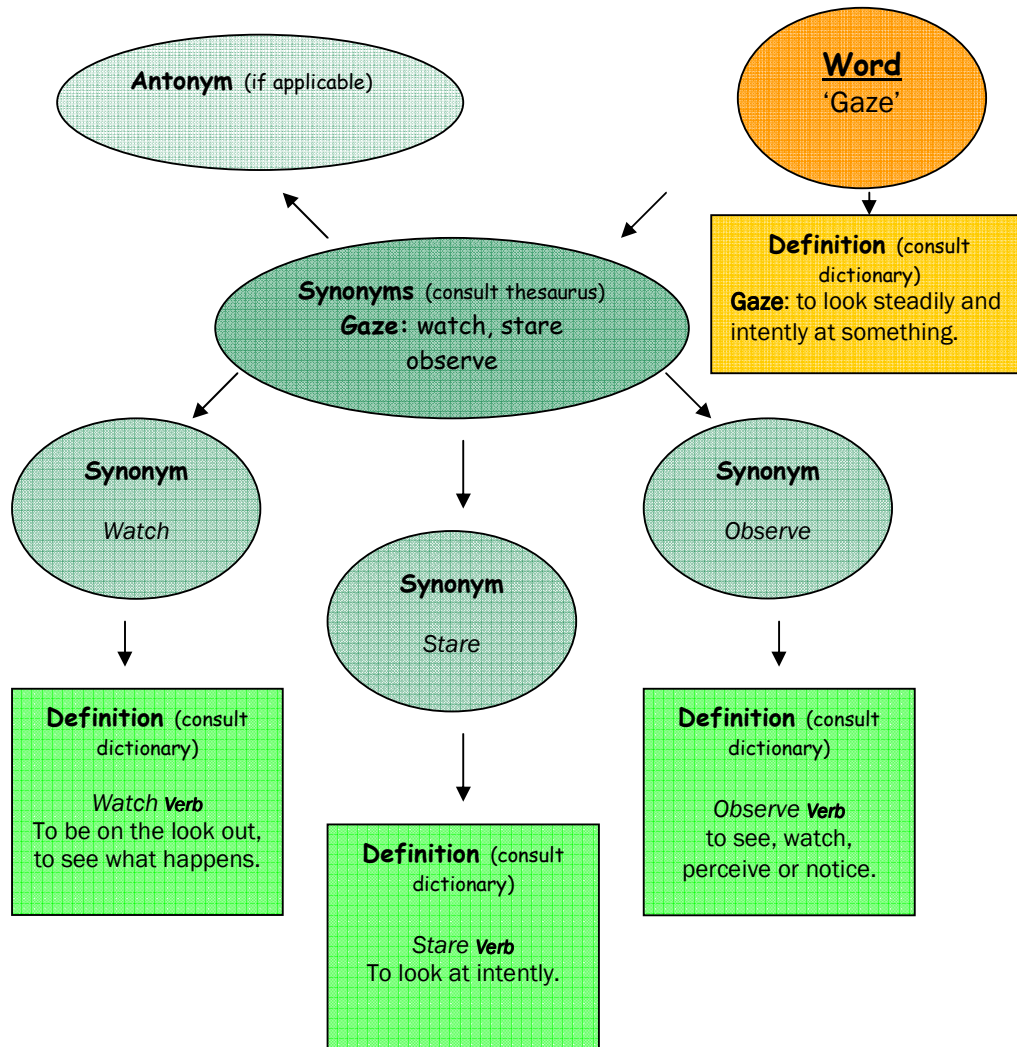
Text-based Intervention – Vocabulary Worksheet (Example)

Target passage from text:
