## Simple Sentence - Questions

When we ask a question we change the order of the words in a sentence. and add a question mark.

The boys are swimming.

Are the boys swimming?

Often we need to change the verb and add words to the sentence for it to make sense as a question.

The horse ran to the gate.

Did the horse run to the gate?

We often use words such as who, what, where and when to create questions.

The boys **are** swimming. **Who are those** boys swimming?

The boys **are** swimming. **What are** the boys swimming **for?** 

The boys **are** swimming. **Where are** the boys swimming **to?** 

The boys **are** swimming. **When will** the boys **go** swimming?
