

Simple Sentence

A sentence expresses a **complete** thought.

A simple sentence contains a **subject**, a **verb**, and often contains an **object**.

A sentence starts with a capital letter (**A**), ends in a full stop (**.**), a question mark (**?**) or exclamation mark (**!**)

Subject: The subject is the noun or pronoun.

Verb: Verbs are **very** important. Every sentence **must** have a verb.

Object: the noun or pronoun to which the **action** of the verb is being done.

Object

in the water
prep phrase (noun)

to the gate.
(noun)
